Admissions Arrangements – Jack Hunt School September 2009

In accordance with The Education and Inspections Act 2006 the Governors of Jack Hunt School consulted you about the proposed admission arrangements for the Academic Year commencing in September 2009. The Governors have reviewed the admissions criteria and they will be as follows:-

The admissions criteria will be applied if there are more students enquiring for entry to the school than there are places available and places will be allocated to those children in the following categories expressed in order of priority:

1. Looked after children (children in public care)
2. Verified medical needs relating to the student (the requirements are strict and need certification by a Doctor). This provision is for children with hearing or physical impairment (up to 5 places)

As the school has provision for students with a physical impairment and for students with a hearing impairment the following will qualify under the criteria:

- Students who have specific needs that require access to the specialist provision and the school is named in the Statement of Special Educational Needs
- Students who have specific needs that require access to the specialist provision and for whom a Statutory Assessment is currently being undertaken.

3. Children living in the following catchment areas for primary schools:-

Gladstone Primary School, Highlees Primary School, Longthorpe Primary School, Middleton Primary School, Ravensthorpe Primary School, Thorpe Primary School and West Town Primary School. This includes children living within the above catchments who may be attending Sacred Heart Primary School and other Primary Schools.

4. Where the child has a brother or sister attending the school at time of admission.
5. Children living closest to the school (*measured by the shortest distance between the home address and the school's nearest official point of entry measured in a straight line*).

Where the number of applications exceeds the number of places under Criterion 3 priority will be given to those living nearest to the school measured by the shortest distance between the home address and the school's nearest official point of entry measured in a straight line.

Where the number of applications exceeds the number of places under Criterion 4 priority will be given to those living nearest to the school measured by the shortest distance between the home address and the school's nearest official point of entry measured in a straight line.

The Published Admission Number for each year is 270.
