

## **St Augustine's CEVA Junior School**

### **Admissions Policy 2009**

**In an aided School the Governing Body is responsible for all matters concerning Pupil Admissions. The Governing Body will admit 53.**

**St Augustine's School serves children living in the vicinity of the school, children from the Parish of Woodston and those from a wider area on religious grounds. In the event of the school being over-subscribed the Governors will allocate places on the following criteria in this order of priority.**

- 1. Looked After Children and those children with Educational Statements naming St Augustine's.**
- 2. Children of parents who regularly worship at St Augustine's Church Woodston or its Sister Church, St Margaret's Fletton.**
- 3. Children of parents who worship at other Christian Churches, who are in association with 'Churches Together in England', and those who wish an education for their children set within a specific religious context.**
- 4. Brothers and sisters of these children who are registered on the school roll at the time of admission.**
- 5. Children moving from Brewster Avenue Infant School.**
- 6. Children of parents who live in the vicinity of St Augustine's School otherwise known as the catchment area as defined in the LA 'Primary Guide For Parents'.**

**Note.**

**In the event of over subscription in any category these children living closest to the school, as measured by safe walking route, will be used to determine places with the closest gaining high priority.**

#### **Appeals**

**There is a right of appeal against a refusal of the Governors to admit any applicant. Any appeal must be made in writing within 21 days of notification of refusal and must be sent to:**
