ADMISSIONS CRITERIA for September 2009

In accordance with the Education Act 2006 and the requirements of the School Admissions Code of Practice, the Governors of St John's Church of England Primary School consulted on the admission arrangements for September 2009. The Governors have reviewed the admissions criteria and they will be as follows:

ST John's Church School serves children who live in streets in the vicinity of the school as well as a wider area on religious grounds. The governors will consider applications for any remaining places from parents who live outside the catchment area who wish their children to attend the school on religious grounds. In the event of the school being over-subscribed with applicants the following criteria will apply:

1. St John's Church School will give priority to children with a statement of Special Educational Needs which names the school. This will be in addition to any specific arrangements to specialist provision.
2. Looked after children
3. Children from families who are worshipping members of Christ Church in Orton Goldhay.
4. Children from families who are worshipping members of other Christian Churches.
5. Brothers and sisters of those attending St. John's at the time of admission.
6. Children from within the school's designated catchment area.

Notes:

- Admission under categories 2 and 3 will require a letter from the relevant church minister.
- Admission under category 5 will be determined by the proximity of the parental home to school by the shortest safe walking distance in a straight line.
- Our Published Admission Number (PAN) for September 2009 is 36.
