**Secondary School Admissions Arrangements, September 2009**

In accordance with the Education Act 2002 and the provisions of the School Admissions Code of Practice, the Governing Body of Stanground College is required to consult, determine and notify its admission arrangements for the College for September 2009.

The Published Admission Number (PAN) for September 2009 for Year 7 is 270

The Published Admission Number (PAN) for September 2009 for Year 12 is 30

The Governing Body, as the admissions Authority, the following admission criteria for the College:

1. The Governing Body will give priority to children with a statement of Special Educational Needs which names the school. This will be in addition to any specific arrangements to specialist provision.'
2. Looked After Children
3. Verified medical need relating to the pupil (the requirements are strict and need certification by a Doctor or Psychologist).
4. The attendance of a brother or sister on the College roll at the time of admission.
5. Children living in the areas of the following Primary Schools: Farcet CE, Fourfields, Heritage Park, Oakdale, Old Fletton, Southfields Junior, St Augustines, Stanground St. John's CE, William de Yaxley CE Junior and Woodston
6. Children living outside the above area according to proximity. The Local Authority have recently adopted a 'straight line' distance measuring process for which there is software available.
