

Appendix A

DESIGNATED SCHOOLS – Effective September 2010

The designated school is the relevant school identified in the Local Authority's admissions guides for parents, which are published annually. Please see policy document for criteria for transport.

Children with Statements of Special Educational Needs will be placed in a school which is judged to be the best to cater for those needs.

PRIMARY

The designated primary schools are those listed in the alphabetical street list of Peterborough indicating catchment primary schools. (Please refer to 'Admission to Primary School 2010-2011')

Exceptions are Sacred Heart and St Thomas More which do not have catchment areas.

SECONDARY

Arthur Mellows Village College is the designated school for children living in the catchment areas of the following primary schools: Barnack CE; Castor CE; Eye VC; John Clare (Helpston); Newborough CE; Northborough; Peakirk cum Glinton CE; The Duke of Bedford (Thorney); Wittering.

Ormiston Bushfield Academy – children living in the catchment area served by the school (please refer to 'Admission to Secondary School 2010-2011').

Hampton College - children living in the catchment area served by the school (please refer to 'Admission to Secondary School 2010-2011').

Jack Hunt School is the designated school for children living in the catchment areas of the following primary schools: Gladstone; Highlees; Longthorpe; Middleton; Ravensthorpe; Thorpe and West Town. This includes children living within the above catchments who may be attending Sacred Heart Primary School and other primary schools.

Ken Stimpson Community School - children living in the catchment area served by the school (please refer to 'Admission to Secondary School 2010-2011').

Orton Longueville School – children living in the catchment area served by the school (please refer to 'Admission to Secondary School 2010-2011').

The King's (The Cathedral) School has no designated catchment area.

St John Fisher RC High School has no designated catchment area.

Stanground College - – children living in the catchment area served by the school (please refer to 'Admission to Secondary School 2010-2011').

The Thomas Deacon Academy – has no catchment area

The Voyager School – Children living in the catchment areas of the following primary schools:- Discovery; Eyrescroft; Fulbridge (west of Lincoln Road); Gunthorpe; Norwood, Paston Ridings (north of Soke Parkway); The Beeches (west of Lincoln Road), Watergall.
