Statement of the Representations Procedure and Arrangements for Inspection of the Peterborough Planning Policies Development Plan Document (Proposed Submission Version)

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with regulation 27 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, as amended by the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008 and the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2009 that Peterborough City Council has published the Peterborough Planning Policies Development Plan Document and it proposes to submit this to the Secretary of State.

Title of the document which the city council proposes to submit to the Secretary of State:	Peterborough Planning Policies Development Plan Document (DPD)
Subject matter and area covered:	The Peterborough Planning Policies DPD sets out detailed policies to help in reaching decisions on planning applications. It covers the whole of the administrative area of Peterborough City Council.
