The Electoral Registration Officer makes and keeps two versions of the electoral register – the FULL Register and the EDITED Register.

The FULL Register lists everyone who is entitled to vote. You can check it, by appointment only, at Peterborough Central Library or at the Town Hall. Only certain people may use it for specified purposes. These include electoral purposes, the prevention and detection of crime and checking your identity when you have applied for credit. The law says who can have a copy of the FULL Register and what they can use it for. It is a criminal offence for them to pass it on to anyone else or to use it for any other purpose.

The EDITED Register leaves out the name and address of people who have asked for them to be excluded from that version of the register. The EDITED register can be bought by anyone who asks for a copy and they may use it for any purpose.
