

Peterborough New Hampton Community Primary School Competition

In accordance with section 7(5) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, Peterborough City Council gives notice that, following the notice of 26 April 2011 inviting proposals for a new mainstream school at Hampton, Peterborough, the following proposals have been received.

The Ely Diocesan Board of Education, Diocesan Office, Barton Road, Ely, CB7 4DX has submitted an independent proposal to establish a new Academy School. The proposal is for an inclusive neighbourhood Academy with a Church of England character and a distinctive ethos based on Christian values. The proposer intends to ask the Secretary of State to designate the school as a school with such a religious character

It is intended that the new Academy will be a fully extended school. Activities will include: homework clubs; varied sports clubs; study support; special interest clubs and activities; wrap around care, 8.00 am to 6.00 pm for pupils aged 4 – 11, and holiday clubs.

The admissions policy will be decided by the governing body in consultation with the Ely Diocesan Board of Education but will be based primarily on local catchment, with priority for other pupils on faith grounds once local catchment needs have been met.

The CfBT Schools Trust (60 Queen's Road, Reading, RG1 4BS – main contact Elaine Radley, Principal Adviser, CfBT Lincolnshire School Improvement Service, The Old Vicarage, County Offices, Newland, Lincoln, LN1 1YQ) has submitted an independent proposal to establish a Community Primary Academy, for girls and boys aged 4 – 11 and to run the community facilities on site.

It is intended that the Academy will provide an extended day with activities and childcare at least from 8.00 am to 6.00 pm on weekdays for 48 weeks of the year. The exact nature of provision will be based on consultation and assessment of need. It is proposed that the Academy will be a nurturing school, firmly rooted in strong Christian values.

Admissions will be on a catchment basis, determined in consultation with the Local Authority.
