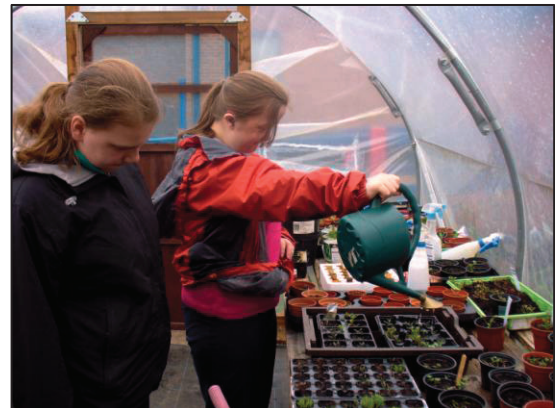
Who is it for?

16-19 year old students with a statement of Educational Need who would like to be more independent in the future. This is a 3 year course.



What will you learn about?

- Basic numeracy, literacy and IT
- Independent skills including cookery
- Personal and social skills
- Music
- Leisure and relaxation
- Work experience
- Careers learning
- Citizenship
- World studies



Students from the Phoenix School Upper School form a Link group to access facilities at City College Peterborough. Here they work with college tutors supported by familiar school staff, and are introduced to college life, making comparisons between the two and meeting and working alongside students already working at the college. The Phoenix Upper School department also liaise with other local providers, including Sense, Peterborough Regional College and the Helping Hands group to ensure that the students receive a breadth of experiences from a wealth of expertise.
