There is a £1.50 admission fee.

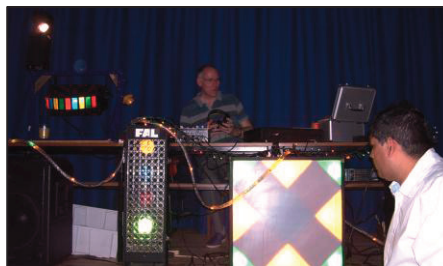
We are unable to provide support to members who are not able to independently look after themselves

The Lava Lamp is a club night for adults over 18 with learning disabilities, organised by adults with learning

disabilities. There are specially trained stewards to make sure you stay safe and enjoy a great night out.

Workshops are run on stewarding and how to DJ before the event, so you could have a go at spinning your favourite tunes or helping to keep everyone safe and sound.

The nightclub is fully wheelchair accessible
