The new Concessionary Bus Fare Scheme - know your facts

Your guide to the new system from 1 October 2006

Changes to the Concessionary Bus Fare Scheme

From 1 October 2006, the Concessionary Bus Fare scheme has been extended to all Peterborough residents who now travel across the whole of Cambridgeshire for free. You can now use the scheme in the whole area of the map and you can also travel in the towns & the whole area. The same fare reductions apply - after 12.00 midday to Fridays and at all times on weekends and Bank Holidays.

If you have an old style orange pass you need to update it. You should have an up-to-date green pass which expires on 31 March 2006.

You do not need to change your photograph. If you are blind or partially sighted you should have a black and white pass. These holding passes because they are blind or partially sighted will be able to travel free at any time as long as their journey starts or finishes in Cambridgeshire.

How to qualify

Bus passes are available to the following groups:

- Pensioners (men and women aged over 65)
- People who qualify for the higher rate mobility component of disability living allowance or the War Pensioners Mobility Supplement
- Those registered deaf
- Those who are unable to speak and use provide medical evidence
- Those who are prevented from obtaining a driving licence or medical grounds
- Those registered blind or partially sighted
- Those who have a learning disability which includes significant impairment of judgement and understanding
- Those who have long term loss of the use of both arms

Where to get your bus pass

You can get your bus pass from the following locations:

- Bayard Place located in Broadway opposite the Central Library
- TravelChoice Centre located in Queensgate Bus Station

You will need to provide a passport sized photograph of yourself and proof that you qualify for the pass. This must include proof of residency and proof of age if applying for the aged 60 and over pass or proof of disability if applying for the disability bus pass.

Community Link

Your guide to accessible door-to-door transport

Welcome to Peterborough's Community Link

Community Link is designed for people who are unable to use, or have difficulty using, public transport or where no public transport is available. Whether you use a wheelchair or not, our specialised transport and professional drivers will help you to obtain independence to travel. The Community Link bus is wheelchair accessible.

Three Community Link services operate one return journey on a daily basis, Tuesdays to Saturdays. Community Link can collect you from your home and take you to the city centre. Having paid your membership, a valid Council bus pass entitles you to travel for free on these services.

Currently 48 hours notification of booking is required.

How to use Community Link

- Ring 01733 317460 to make a booking. The booking line is open Mondays to Fridays 9.00 am to 5.00 pm - an answer phone will be in operation outside of these hours.
- Ring up to 48 hours prior to your required journey, however lines close at 12.00 noon on the day prior to travel.
- Inform the operator of your name, membership number and journey details.
- The operator will inform you of an appropriate collection time.
- The driver can collect you from your door, wherever possible.
- The driver can assist you on and off the vehicle.
- The driver will assist you with your shopping of up to 4 carrier bags per person.
