### **Determined Secondary School Admission Arrangements for September 2010**

In accordance with the Education Act 2006 and the requirements of the School Admissions Code of Practice, the Interim Executive Board/Governing Body of St John Fisher Catholic High School have consulted on the admission arrangements for September 2010.

The Interim Executive Board/Governing Body will admit up to 133 pupils in each year group.

In order to preserve the Catholic nature of the school, the Interim Executive Board/Governing Body will admit pupils according to the following criteria if the school is oversubscribed;

The Interim Executive Board/Governing Body will give priority to children with a statement of Special Educational Needs which names the school. This will be in addition to any specific arrangements to specialist provision.

1. Looked After Baptised Catholic Children.
2. Baptised Catholic children attending the feeder schools:
  - All Saints' School, March
  - St Augustine's School, Stamford
  - St Thomas More School, Peterborough
  - Sacred Heart School, Bretton.
3. Other Baptised Catholic children.
4. Other Looked After Children.
5. Siblings of children attending St John Fisher Catholic High School at the time of admission.
6. Other children attending the feeder schools:
  - All Saints' School, March
  - St Augustine's School, Stamford
  - St Thomas More School, Peterborough
  - Sacred Heart School, Bretton.
7. Children of other denominations and faiths

8. Any other child.

In the event of oversubscription in any category, priority will be given to those living closest to the school measured by a straight line from the centre of the home address to the school using the National Ordnance Survey set points via the LA's computerised measuring system.

Please note that for the benefit of these criteria children are siblings if parents and children live together in the same household., they are half or full brother or sister, living together in the same household; or they are adoptive brother or sister, living together in the same household

The school operates a waiting list. Children will be added to this list, on request, in criteria order. Children who are the subject of a direction by the Local Authority to admit, or who are allocated to a school in accordance with an In-Year Fair Access Protocol, must take precedence over those on a waiting list. .
