By 1943 The Forgrove Machinery Company Ltd of Leeds had also been acquired by Baker Perkins, thus extending the wide range of wrapping and packaging machinery manufactured. In 1967, the two companies were amalgamated as Rose Forgrove Ltd and went on to become the largest manufacturer of wrapping and packaging machinery in the world.
