The John Clare Trust purchased Clare Cottage in 2005. It has been restored using traditional methods. The Cottage contains examples of his work, together with information about his life.

Queensgate Bus Information Display Boards

Two electronic bus information display boards have recently been installed in Queensgate shopping centre, located next to the information kiosk outside John Lewis. The displays show the bus departure times from the bus station using real time passenger
