

Get in the Zone at Leighton School!

Are you in the zone? It takes less than 10 minutes to walk or cycle from the zones on the map to school, so give it a go! It makes you feel great and reduces congestion outside the school, making it safer too!

Outside the zone? Why not park at one of the boundary lines and walk the rest, car share with friends, or catch the bus to school?



Key

Buses running Monday to Friday...

- Blue circle: ...every 10 minutes
- Red circle: ...every 10 and 20 minutes
- Green circle: ...every 20 and 30 minutes
- Orange circle: ...between 30 and 60 minutes
- Yellow circle: Less than hourly bus service
- Grey circle: Only operates in direction shown
- Black circle: Bus stop

Other symbols:

- Red square with 'S': Bus service terminus
- Red circle with 'AGPG': Text 'PET' and the 4 letter code shown (e.g. PETAGG) to 84268
- Black circle with 'N': National rail line and station
- Black circle with 'H': Heritage rail line and station
- Red line: Recommended on-road cycle route
- Blue line: Traffic-free cycle and walking route

Additional symbols:

- Red circle with 'No cycling please walk': No cycling please walk
- Red triangle with 'A': Signalled crossing
- Black triangle with 'Level crossing': Level crossing
- Black square with 'Subway': Subway
- Black square with 'Zebra crossing': Zebra crossing
- Red circle with '12': National Cycle Network route number
- Green circle with '21': Green Wheel cycle route
- Red circle with 'GW': Green Wheel cycle route
- Red circle with 'P': Pedestrian area
- Red circle with 'W': Walking route
