

AN INVITATION

Peterborough City Council invites you to attend this exhibition that provides advanced information regarding the proposed A1139 Fletton Parkway junction 2-3 widening scheme. Information will also be available on the Hampton footbridge, which has been given planning permission. City Council officers and Atkins staff, their consulting engineers, will be available to discuss the proposals in detail.

THE PROBLEM

The A1139 Fletton Parkway currently carries approximately 64,500 vehicles a day and heavy congestion occurs at peak periods between junctions 2-3 and also at the junction 3 roundabout.

THE FUTURE WITHOUT ACTION

Considerable growth is planned for Peterborough. Without the scheme queues and delays will worsen on Fletton Parkway as a result of the forecast traffic growth, particularly by the continued development of Hampton and the Hampton Western Peripheral Road.

FUNDING

£7 million is allocated to deliver this scheme from the Government's Community Infrastructure Fund.

PROPOSED TIMESCALES FOR THE HIGHWAY SCHEME

- September 2006: Initial design
- October 2006: Refine detailed design
- November 2006: Approval to construct scheme
- July 2007: Start construction
- March 2008: Scheme completion

CYCLEWAY AND FOOTBRIDGE

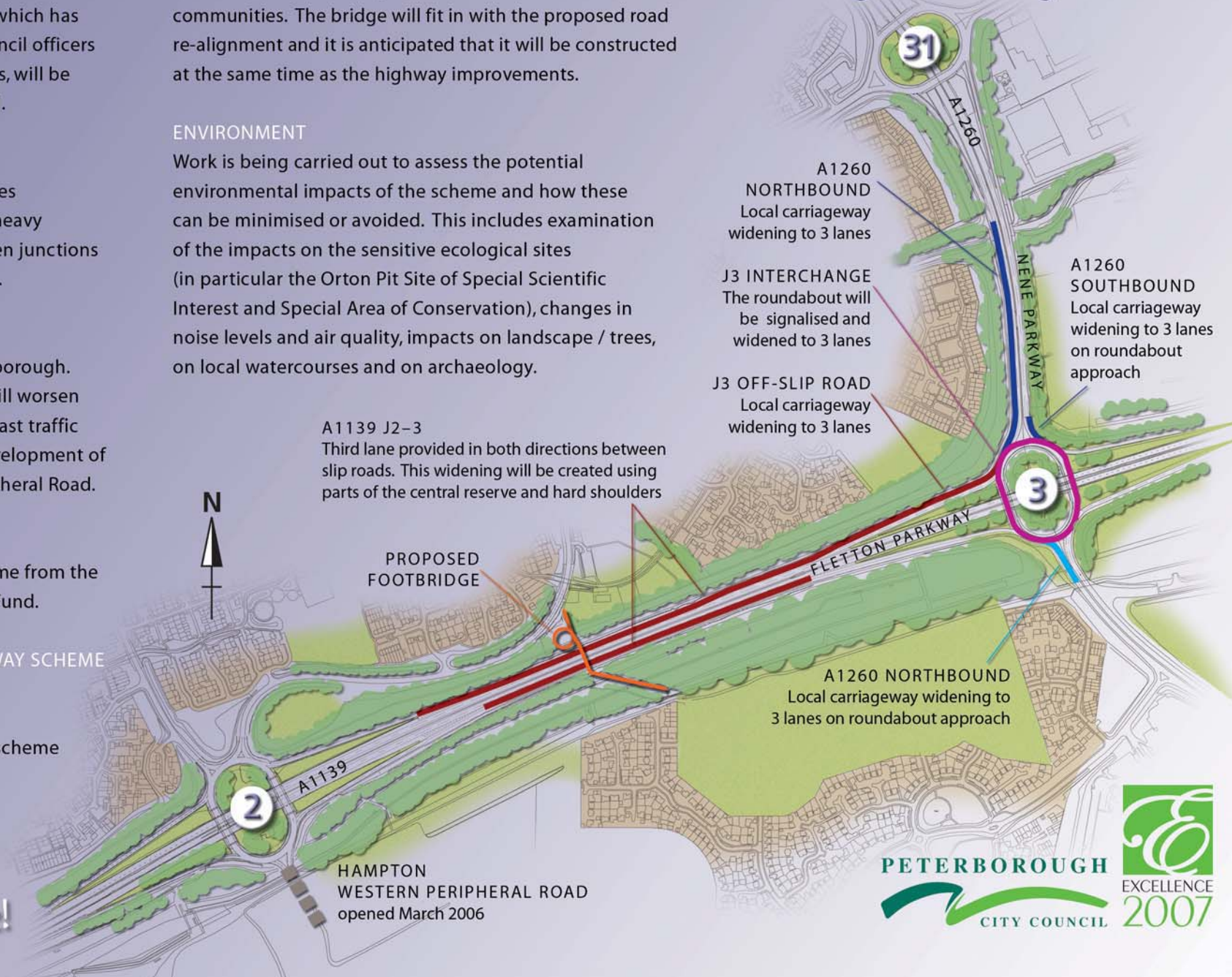
The Hampton developers have been granted planning approval for a footbridge and cycleway to be provided to link the Hampton and Orton housing areas. The bridge across the A1139 will improve access between the two communities. The bridge will fit in with the proposed road re-alignment and it is anticipated that it will be constructed at the same time as the highway improvements.

ENVIRONMENT

Work is being carried out to assess the potential environmental impacts of the scheme and how these can be minimised or avoided. This includes examination of the impacts on the sensitive ecological sites (in particular the Orton Pit Site of Special Scientific Interest and Special Area of Conservation), changes in noise levels and air quality, impacts on landscape / trees, on local watercourses and on archaeology.

SUPPORTING THE WIDER POLICY CONTEXT

The scheme will:

- Reduce existing levels of traffic congestion;
- Allow existing development proposals to be completed;
- Cater for forecast traffic growth; and
- Provide capacity for future development.

The proposed scheme aligns with a number of the long term objectives set out in the second Peterborough Local Transport Plan:

• ACCESSIBILITY

by improving links between the Hampton development and the Ortons.

• ECONOMY

by improving access to employment for residents of the Hampton development, and access to the employment elements of the development.

• EFFICIENCY

by addressing an existing congestion 'hot spot' the performance of the existing surrounding network is improved, promoting best use of existing infrastructure.

• ENVIRONMENT

by minimising the environmental effects of transport on local communities.
