OLD LINCOLN ROAD - DEEPING GATE
PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that on the 7 October 2021 the Council of the City of Peterborough, (herein after referred to as "the Council") made the above Order under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of vehicles on the following length of road:

Old Lincoln Road, Deeping Gate – access to this road will be restricted by way of bollards for a distance of 36m north of the B1162. This order is to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road

There will be exceptions for vehicles being used for Fire, Ambulance and Police services and for the purposes of maintenance of the Highway and access to adjoining land.

This Amendment Order will amend and make further parking restrictions to the Council of the City of Peterborough (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Order 2013 to the extent only as set out below. In all other respects the above Order and its previous amendments remain in force.

This Order will come into effect on the 11 October 2021
