The re-opening ceremony of a Peterborough pub and a Mediterranean food festival are dates in the Mayoral diary for the coming week.

**Thursday 6 September** - The Mayor will cut a ribbon at the re-opening ceremony of the Halcyon pub in Atherstone Avenue, Peterborough from 10.30am until 11.30am.

**Thursday 6 September** - The Mayor and Mayoress will attend an annual reception event at RAF Wittering between 5pm and 7.45pm.
