Friday 3 July: The Mayor and Mayoress will attend Peterborough Multicultural Festival where the Mayor will make a speech. The event will be held at Jack Hunt School Sports Centre, Ledbury Road, Netherton, Peterborough between 1.30pm and 4.30pm.
