Power supply to an area of street lighting in Orton, Peterborough, is currently out of operation.

This is due to a road traffic accident on Brimbles Way, near the Ortongate Shopping Centre, that resulted in extensive damage to the street lighting and the feeder pillar that provides power to the neighbouring area on Sunday 25 October 2015.

The streets affected are Brimbles Way, Orton Parkway, Newcombe Way, Paxton Road and the local subways under the Orton Centre roundabout.

Due to the specialist equipment required to repair the damage to the pillar, this fault will not be able to be repaired until mid-December at the earliest.

However, works will be undertaken earlier should any opportunity arise.
